

Be Kind You Might Be Helping an Angel!

Bible Verse:

“Don’t forget to show love to strangers, for some who have done this have entertained angels without knowing it.” — Hebrews 13:2

Lesson:

A long time ago, a man named **Abraham** was sitting outside his tent (Genesis 18). He looked up and saw **three strangers** standing nearby. He didn’t know who they were — but he ran to them, offered them food, water, and a place to rest.

Guess what? Those visitors were **angels**, and one of them was even **the Lord!** Because Abraham was kind, he received a special blessing — God promised him and Sarah that they would have a baby boy named **Isaac**.

Later, in **Genesis 19**, Abraham’s nephew **Lot** saw two men come into his city, Sodom. Lot invited them into his home, gave them dinner, and a safe place to sleep. Those men were **angels too**, and they **saved Lot and his family** from danger!

What This Means for Us:

We may not see angels with wings or shining clothes, but sometimes **God sends people into our lives to see how kind we will be.**

It could be a new kid at school, someone who looks lonely, or even a person who needs help carrying something heavy.

When we show kindness, we are **showing love to God.**
